On behalf of our practices and staff in Doncaster South PCN, we would like to wish you a Happy and healthy New Year.

December Highlights...

- In December our Care Coordinators have processed; 29 Social Prescribing referrals, 8 Health and Wellbeing referrals and 2 weight management referrals. They have also arranged 180 Structured Medication Reviews across the South and invited 89 patients to have blood pressure checks to reinforce work around Cardiovascular Disease
- 47 patients had their initial appointment with the Chronic Pain Support Service in November. 9 patients had their initial appointment with the Frailty, Falls and Mobility Service

South Doncaster PCN out and about in December

Care Coordinators have been out and about in our communities again during the last month, meeting our patients and encouraging conversations about health and wellbeing, whilst offering basic health checks and promoting cancer screening and awareness.

PCN Community Basic Health Checks

In recent months the Care Coordinators and Clinical Pharmacists have been holding events at local community and outreach centres to provide basic health checks. At the beginning of December Beth, Paige and Osama visited the Helping Hands Community Centre in Edlington, where they provided opportunities for patients to speak to them about their health and wellbeing concerns. They provided advice about services available, completed referrals and carried out basic health checks including blood pressure and pulse checks, BMI calculations and more.

The team have had a really positive response since starting these health check events and aim to be consistent in their approach to improving access to healthcare within the community.

We have listened to feedback received so far and will be introducing blood glucose testing to the health check service, with the aim increasing detection of undiagnosed diabetes.
