January Care Coordinator and ARRS team Highlights...

- 37 Social Prescribing referrals & 7 Health and Wellbeing referrals - as of February 2024 referral to both of these services has finished
- Our Clinical Pharmacists have carried out 189 Structured Medication Reviews with patients and our pharmacy team have completed 521 medication reconciliations
- 223 patients were sent messages to have blood pressure checks to reinforce work around Cardiovascular Disease
- 13 weight management referrals were processed for patients to take part in the Digital Weight Management Programme
- 72 patients had their initial appointment with the Chronic Pain Support Service
- Our Mental Health Practitioner Emma Nelthorpe had 95 successful appointments and 9 DNAs. She is now joined in the South Mental Health Practitioner team by Stacey Gill who begun seeing patients this month



Advantages of seeing a pharmacist:





Care Coordinators have been out and about in our communities again during the last month, meeting our patients and encouraging conversations about health and wellbeing, whilst offering basic health checks and promoting cancer screening and awareness




PCN Community Basic Health Checks

In recent months the Care Coordinators and Clinical Pharmacists have been holding events at local community and outreach centres to provide basic health checks.

At the end of January Elise, Eden and Osama visited the Helping Hands Community Centre in Edlington, where they provided opportunities for patients to speak to them about their health and wellbeing concerns. They provided advice about services available, completed referrals and carried out basic health checks including blood pressure and pulse checks, BMI calculations and more.

The team have had a really positive response since starting these health check events and aim to be consistent in their approach to improving access to healthcare within the community. Zoe also attended Helping Hands to provide help around the NHS App during the Tablet Course which was running on the same day as the health checks



Cervical Screening Event

As part of Cervical Cancer Prevention week we helped to host a drop-in Cervical Screening event at **The Martinwells Centre**. Care Coordinators Eden and Zoe were joined by Sally Abbott, Lead Colposcopist at DBTH and her colleague as part of their screening outreach project and we are pleased to report that this was a very successful day with some great patient feedback received. Out of the 20 available screening appointments on the day 17 ladies were screened - two of which had not been screened in the last 5 years and 3 of which had never been screened before



We continue to work with Sally to support with future events including a further Drop in / Pre Bookable Cervical Screening Event in Rossington Practice on March 22nd 2024
